Eligibility Requirements :

- **High school diploma or GED Certificate**
- **Current college/university student**
- **Students graduating from high school or completing GED in Academic Year School Year 2018/19 and providing documented intent to attend college in 2019/20 Academic School Year**
- **Indian Preference Policy will apply:**
 1. **Enrolled Klamath Tribal Member**
 2. **Descendant of an enrolled Klamath Tribal member/Certificate of Indian Blood**
 3. **Enrolled Member of another Federally Recognized Tribe**

All CIP applicants selected for potential hire are required to pass a Drug/Alcohol Test; in addition a Background Check including Fingerprints will be required for some positions.
