The College Intern Program runs up to 11 weeks/depending on college student's schedule

Wages: \$14.00/hour

First-time employed college students may be attending an Orientation to Employment in July 2021

Eligibility Requirements :

- High school diploma or GED Certificate
- Current college/university student
- Students graduating from high school or completing GED in Academic School Year 2020/21 and providing documented intent to attend college in 2021/22 Academic School Year
- Indian Preference Policy will apply:
 1. Enrolled Klamath Tribal Member
 2. Descendant of an enrolled Klamath Tribal member/Certificate of Indian Blood
 3. Enrolled Member of another Federally Recognized Tribe

All CIP applicants selected for potential hire are required to pass a Background Check that may include Fingerprints required for some positions.
