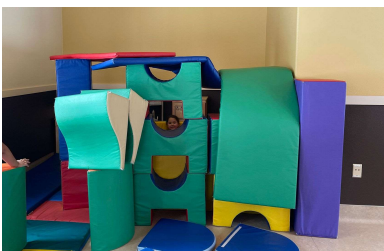

We try to go outside every day if possible. Spring weather brings with it some uncertainty. The ground may be wet/muddy/icy and the temperature may be cold. We recommend sending your child with a large coat, gloves/mittens, hats, boots, spare socks, etc. If you need help obtaining these items for your child, please let us know.

Children have been bringing in many outside toys and foods when they arrive for class. While this is exciting for classmates, it can be a disruption as well as a hazard for other students. Outside foods can cause jealousy between students and be choking or allergy hazards if shared. Toys can be fought over and broken if not kept separate from classroom items available for all children. If your child has a special item or snack please let your child's teacher know so we can adapt accordingly.
