Indian Preference Policy will apply:


- Enrolled Klamath Tribal Member

- Recently graduated from high school, alternative school during the <u>2022/23 Academic</u> <u>Year.</u>
- Priority will be given to first time applicants.

JOBS START JULY 10TH AND RUN THROUGH AUGUST 31ST.

Applicants may need to clear a background check; and some positions may require fingerprinting.
